Job Title:

Warehouse Driver

Job Summary:

The Warehouse Driver will collect donated items and distribute them to the appropriate location.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Ensure proper scheduling and pick up of all donated items.
- Maintains maintenance and mileage logs.
- Maintains the cleanliness of the interior and exterior of the vehicles
- Ensures vehicles are prepared for weekly pick-ups (fuel)
- Assisting with unloading and shelving food as needed
- Work with the Food Pantry Manager to organize a pickup plan that includes driving to and picking up food at multiple locations every morning
- Lift boxes and load and unload from the vehicle.
- Safely operate a motor vehicle, following both traffic laws and Loaves and Fishes's policies

Teamwork and Collaboration:

- Work with the Food Pantry Manager to ensure residents are receiving food services.
- Assist with distribution to clients in our off-site shelter services.
- Role models effective team behaviors
- Participates in team meetings.
- Demonstrates effective communication skills in building relationships with all employees, clients, and donors.
- Communicate with stores and vendors to confirm the pick up of food and supplies
- Works with the warehouse team to ensure proper storing and distribution of donated items.
